message from the president barry vandermolen



The Fall Fling shoot date is earlier this year to get away from the rainy season. Yahi will put the event on the Sunday before Halloween, October 30th. Also different this year will be the choice of targets. In place of paper NFAA animal targets our 3Ds get setup. A no-cost 1-arrow 14-target tournament with awards is planned on Saturday following setup for workers. Club members are also encouraged to come out Sunday and shoot the 3-arrow 14-target event, particularly if you can't make it Saturday.

Saturday 3Ds have been going well thanks to all of you who setup and shoot these events. This spring we discussed adding an additional Saturday in August. We're going to keep to the traditional ten shoots. The last Saturday 3D shoot is August 6th.

Many Yahi members are busy with preparations for archery seasons. Coastal archery deer season already started, others begin real soon. We've been tuning bows and shooting dozens of arrows. All that energy loosens screws, wears cables, strings and servings. Avoid unexpected equipment problems with an extra intense inspection of gear.

From reports of early deer scouting trips I'm hearing of some nice bucks in the Sierra. Snowmelt off is late this year. The high country is full of browse with water everywhere. Could make for some challenging conditions. Bears are out too.

We've been called to provide an archery event for a group of kids and parents Saturday July 30th. Kind of short notice but the call came late. This is another way Yahi can help the community and promote the sport of archery.

Most everybody is afield for the next couple of months. Again this year there will be no 2nd week Sunday Club shoot or 3rd Wednesday Club meetings during August or September. I will be available off and on to handle range problems or other business. Call me at 345-4762, leave a message if I don't answer. A return the call may have to wait 'till I get back into a cell phone coverage area.

Late season rain has kept weeds thriving on the range. Curt Stevenot and Ross Schemmel cut weeds off the first fourteen targets. Weed whacking the other half needs to be accomplished for the Nick Cupini Fall Fling. Mike Evola welded up 18 target markers and dipped them in primer so they're ready for marker maintenance. To help refresh marker paint give me a call, club does provide paint, stencils and directions.
