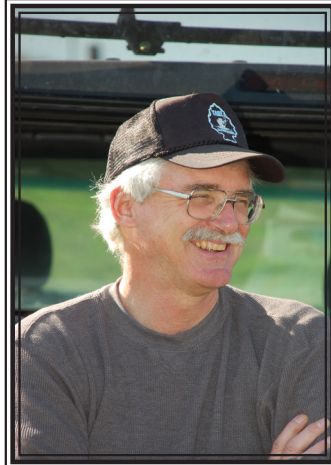

Soil is saturated.

Targets are saturated with some needing to be replaced, waiting for roads to dry for vehicle traffic. Jerry Callaway replaced the worst of the practice range targets.

20 gallons of herbicide applied by Ed Andrade is taking hold and burning down weeds around yardage markers, steps, benches, etc. This will make weed control easier. Weeds look OK now, don't expect a need to begin cutting them for a couple more weeks.

Gary Alfrey, Judy Hienz, Jerry Callaway, Jim Murphy, Larry Franco and Barry Vandermolen pulled 3D targets out to appraise their condition for the coming year.

Tournament and Saturday 3D assignments were determined.

Shot out Reinhart inserts were replaced in raccoon, bobcat, red fox, Spanish goat, coyote, & javalina, targets. Needed but didn't have an insert for the lion.

Targets for disposal to offer club members include wolverine, raccoon, bobcat, two deer, and a turkey. These 3Ds are heavily used and are not suitable for club use or repair.

The group worked fast appraising target condition, replacing inserts, and assigning targets. Previous assignments were painted over prior to returning targets to storage.

Jerry Callaway has contacted Reinhart for a new catalog and price list. Reinhart has not raised prices yet this year. Jerry will obtain a quote for recommended replacements.

Raglin targets need foam repairs. Scoring rings need to be marked on some and should be reworked on others.
