March offers a variety of organized archery sport events. Tournaments this month are scheduled close to home. Join in the fun and help make YAH I Bowmen's presence known.

Our own Spring Fling, a three arrow marked yardage 28 target 3-D shoot, will be held March 27th, at the Archery Range at Modesto Reservoir. Registration starts at 8:00 a.m.. Targets are North American critters ranging from bobcat and raccoon size to caribou and bear. Shooting this tournament is a great way to support your club.

Water receded from Orestimba Field Archers' range where we'll go to their High Water event March 13th. This is a one arrow unmarked yardage 28 target 3-D shoot beginning at 10:00 a.m.. The range is located at the confluence of the Merced and San Joaquin Rivers. Meet at 8:00 a.m. for breakfast and carpool from the Black Bear Diner in Modesto, (2200 Plaza Parkway). Let's have some fun, and support our flooded out neighbors!

March 20th is Horseshoe's Buffalo Shoot. This is a three arrow marked yardage 28 target 3D shoot located about ten miles past La Grange on Hwy 132. Shoot time is 9:00 a.m.; registration begins at 7:30 a.m.. Meet at 6:45 a.m. for breakfast at Kathy's in Waterford.
